**Review Proposed Reimbursement Plan for
Stimulus Funds from the American Rescue Plan
Act of 2021**

1. How does the Main Street Moves (\$1.5m) and City Hall Repairs (\$1.8m) spur the local economy and Generate Revenue?
2. Of the \$27.6 in taxes, only 11% (\$3.2m) will be spent on the economy. Yet, there will be a negative budget projected over the next 5 years. This does not even address the estimated \$10 million that needs to be replaced by the loss of the Players Club taxes.
3. What are the plans to fill vacancies in the commercial market?
4. Now that one City Council member has suggested that the Pacific View Mall become housing, what are the plans to partner up with the Mall and strengthen the retail business in Ventura?
5. Nothing in this spending plan seems to address greater tourism and more jobs for Ventura. What is the plan to increase jobs in Ventura?
6. How will Ventura market itself to keep its local workforce from leaving?
