Written Comments

I am a renter in Ventura, where I have lived for the last 8 years. In looking at the proposed budget, the current allocation for police funding from the General Fund is disproportionate at 34% of the proposed GF budget. Right now the U.S. is in turmoil as a result of systemic racism and police brutality to black lives and other people of color. Individuals and organizations across the country are asking for cities and states to defund the police - its critical that we acknowledge and are accountable for the devaluation and dehumanization of Black life at the hands of the police. Given that this is an opportunity for Ventura to be a leader in California around valuing Black lives, it is essential that we as a city adjust our own way of operating by not having the majority of GF funding go to the police but instead investing our budget in community resources and programs. In addition, I have attached a document of other principles Ventura should adopt.
