SPECIAL MEETING

JULY 15, 2020

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE STAY AT HOME ORDER AND THE COUNTY OF VENTURA HEALTH OFFICER DECLARED LOCAL HEALTH EMERGENCY AND BE WELL AT HOME ORDER RESULTING FROM THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19), CITY HALL IS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC. TO FIND OUT HOW YOU MAY ELECTRONICALLY ATTEND THE CITY COUNCIL MEETING AND PROVIDE PUBLIC COMMENT PLEASE REFER TO PAGE 2 OF THIS AGENDA.

City Council conducted this meeting in accordance with California Governor Newsom's Executive Orders N-20-20 and N-35-20 and COVID-19 pandemic protocols.

1. CALL TO ORDER – SPECIAL MEETING

The San Buenaventura (Ventura) City Council met in Special Session to discuss the Father Serra Statues utilizing WebEx Events Meeting software from various Ventura locations at 6:02 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

PRESENT: Councilmembers Nasarenko, Brown, Friedman, Heitmann, Weir, and Deputy Mayor Rubalcava (via teleconference/video conference)

ABSENT: Mayor LaVere

Deputy Mayor Rubalcava presided.

It is noted for the minutes that Mayor LaVere has recused himself from these proceedings due to a conflict of interest with signing a letter on this topic of the Father Serra Statue relocation in the July 7, 2020 meeting on this topic. Therefore, Mayor LaVere was absent from the meeting. Mayor LaVere attended the meeting as an attendee.

3. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Councilmembers Brown and Nasarenko led the pledge of allegiance.

City Clerk Antoinette Mann announced that the meeting currently had 317 participants with 132 speakers currently on tonight's list.

12. FORMAL ITEM (continued)

After Staff Presentation and prior to hearing the public speakers, there was discussion related to the time allotted and to stop adding names to the speaker list for Agenda Item 12A. City Council agreed to one minute for each speaker.

Deputy Mayor Rubalcava inquired with City Clerk Mann if the time had ended to add speakers to the list. City Clerk Mann inquired if that was the direction Council was giving. City Attorney Diaz reminded council that stopping to add names to the list prior to Council discussion would require a motion to adjust City Council Protocols.

Councilmember Nasarenko moved to adjust City Council Protocols to allow that no additional speaker's names to be added to the current public speakers list. Seconded by Councilmember Brown. The vote was as follows:

A few Public Speakers that were unable to be unmuted prior to recess were given their time to speak.

Council deliberation/discussion conducted related to the Father Serra Statues

Councilmember Brown moved to approve staff recommendation to:

Find that the Bronze Statue does not meet the requirements for historic designation, based on the recommendation of the Historic Preservation Committee and the report prepared by the Historic Resources Group. As the Wood Statue was a part of the molding process for the Bronze Statue, the Wood Statue also does not meet the requirements for historic designation.

Councilmember Nasarenko seconded. The vote was as follows:

City Clerk Antoinette M. Mann declared the motion carried 6 Yes; 0-No; 1 Absent (Mayor LaVere).

12. FORMAL ITEM (continued)

Councilmember Nasarenko moved to approve staff recommendation to:

Determine that the commonsense exemption from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) found in Section 15061 of the State CEQA Guidelines applies and adopt said exemption based on the fact the determination to remove or relocate a non-historic statue will not have a significant impact on the environment.

Councilmember Brown seconded. The vote was as follows:

City Clerk Antoinette M. Mann declared the motion carried 6 Yes; 0-No; 1 Absent (Mayor LaVere).

Councilmember Nasarenko moved to approve:

Relocate the Bronze and Wood Statues to the Mission San Buenaventura.

Seconded by Councilmember Friedman. No vote taken.

Council discussion was then conducted on the motion on the floor.

Councilmember Heitmann asked to include that we remove the Statues and take it to a safe place to be kept until it can be moved to the mission. Stating that the removal will not be an overnight situation. Requested an amendment to the motion to make it safer.

Councilmember Nasarenko stated he was fine with doing whatever preserves both statues and maintains their integrity and does not cause and delay or damage. So, I think I will just express this more as in intention in the motion as:

That we relocate the Bronze and Wood Statue from their present locations on City property to locations deemed appropriate and feasible by staff with the ultimate preference that it go to the Mission San Buenaventura.

Councilmember Nasarenko inquired with Councilmember Heitmann if the amended motion met her concerns. Councilmember Heitmann stated the amended motion met her concerns.

12. FORMAL ITEM (continued)

Councilmember Brown inquired if the motion should be adjusted "preference" to intent in the motion since we do not know the ultimate disposition at this time.

Councilmember Nasarenko stated he was fine with Councilmember Brown's recommendation and restated the motion as:

Relocate the Bronze and Wood Statue from their present location on City property to a location deemed feasible by staff with the intent of City Council that they go to the Mission San Buenaventura.

Councilmember Nasarenko inquired with Councilmember Friedman, as he had seconded the motion is the modified motion (Relocate the Bronze and Wood Statue from their present location on City property to a location deemed feasible by staff with the intent of City Council that they go to the Mission San Buenaventura) was approved.

Councilmember Friedman approved the amended motion and stated he appreciated Councilmember Brown's comment as there could be a problem relocating it to the mission. We know that is our intent, but in the meantime, it is in a place where it is safe until it is relocated.

Councilmember Brown requested that the full and entire motion be repeated.

Councilmember Nasarenko repeated the motion as:

Relocate the Bronze and Wood Statues, presently on City property to a location that staff deems feasible and appropriate with the ultimate intent to place both Statues at Mission San Buenaventura.

Councilmember Brown inquired if we were adding permanent removal to the motion.

Councilmember Nasarenko stated the intent of the motion is the permanent relocation, so I am happy to add permanent relocation to the motion, if the Councilmembers desire.

Deputy Mayor Rubalcava said she would support the addition to the motion.

Councilmember Nasarenko inquired with Councilmember Friedman, as the seconder of the motion, how he felt about the addition. Councilmember Friedman, as the seconder to the motion, stated he supported adding permanent into the motion.

12. FORMAL ITEM (continued)

Councilmember Nasarenko inquired with Councilmember Brown is that addition was satisfactory. Councilmember Brown stated yes.

Deputy Mayor Rubalcava recognized that Councilmember Weir had a comment.

Councilmember Weir inquired that about the wood statue. The wood statue, there has been interest shown on the wood statue from lot of other places, other than the Mission and the Mission may not be able to accommodate both statutes. Can we leave the wood statues ultimate destination a little more open ended in the motion.

Councilmember Nasarenko inquired if amending the motion to include that the intent of the Bronze Statue is to go the San Buenaventura Mission whereas the Wood Statue would go to a location deemed appropriate at a later time.

Councilmember Weir stated this amendment met her concerns.

Councilmember Nasarenko inquired with Councilmember Friedman, as the seconder of the motion, if he supported this amendment. Councilmember Friedman, as the seconder to the motion, stated he supported the amendment.

City Council voted on Councilmember Nasarenko's motion: to

Permanently relocate the Bronze and Wood Statue on City property to a safe location that staff deems feasible and appropriate with the ultimate intent to place the Bronze Statue at the San Buenaventura Mission and for the Wood Statue to remain in safe location with the location deemed appropriate at a later time.

Councilmember Friedman seconded. The vote was as follows:

15. COUNCIL COMMUNICATIONS

Deputy Mayor Rubalcava thanked City Council for their patient and active participation during this community deliberation. Thanked the community members that got involved and participated. Thanked our Chumash community members that stepped and spoke up, and made their voices heard. Thanked the City Clerk Mann and Assistant City Clerk Oehler for managing the hundreds of public comments at the two public meetings on the Statues.

Councilmember Nasarenko stated he failed to mention the author of the book he relied upon in his findings on Junipero Serra and who was co-curator of the exhibit he visited/saw at the Huntington Library, his name is Steven Hackel, with this book titled "Junipero Serra California's Founder Father."

Councilmember Friedman stated we have heard over the last public hearings the frustrations people are having with calling in and their technical problems. I think there was a couple people tonight who were very frustrated tonight and feels we are not allow all ranges of our population to participate. This is not fun for any of us. We are sitting in our little rooms talking to our computers, with all sorts of technical problems, at the time. Obviously, we are not doing this because we want to; we are doing this as we deal with the world-wide pandemic that has hit us and our ability to conduct business the way we have been conducting it since 1866. We are not allowed to gather in our chambers and to have a bunch of people in there. So just know that we are doing the best we can. This is not ideal. I know that City Clerk Mann and Assistant City Clerk Oehler, the work they are doing, we cannot thank you enough. It requires a lot more effort to do things this way then being in the same room. Hopefully, we will be getting back to normal, someday soon. But in the meantime, this is what we have, and we are just going to have to make the best of it. I just wanted to make those comments because I know people are frustrated and we are too.

Deputy Mayor Rubalcava said that she has heard the same complaints. In these times, I think that everybody is doing the best they can. So, a special shout out to our staff members, Mr. Diaz, Mr. Gilli, Mr. Heglund, Mr. McIntyre to our City Clerk's. Thank you to all our staff, for all the work you have put in and thank you to all of your teams as well. We know it isn't just one person but a whole team working behind the scenes. Thank you all very much.
