Incident: Child Endangerment and Violently Resisting Officers Arrest

Location: Bayshore Inn, 3075 E. Main Street

Date/Time Occurred: 9/9/16 @ 1236 hours

Suspect(s): Allison Silva, 29 years of Ventura

Narrative:

On the above date and time patrol officers responded to a call for service to check on the well-being call of a tenant at the hotel. When the officers arrived, they contacted the suspect in a room and attempted to check on her and her infant child. She immediately grabbed the child and ran from officers. As the officers pursued after her, she ran towards the back of the hotel unit and attempted to jump out of the second story window with the child. Officers were able to grab her before she got out of the window, and they were able to free the child from her as well. The suspect became very combative with officers, kicking and hitting them several times during the struggle over the child and after the child was removed from her. The suspect was ultimately taken into custody by the officers.

At the conclusion of the investigation, the suspect was arrested and booked into Ventura County Jail for child endangerment and violently resisting officers. No one was injured during this incident.
