Incident: Hit and Run with injuries

Narrative:

On the above date and time, VPD patrol officers responded to a report of an injury traffic accident involving a vehicle that had struck a motorcyclist.

While officers and medical personnel were on the way witnesses reported that the driver of the vehicle fled the area on foot leaving the scene of the accident.

Officers located the victim motorcyclist who had suffered a moderate injury to his leg. After initially being treated at the scene the victim was transported by ambulance to a hospital.

Officers investigating the accident obtained evidence from the vehicle that was abandoned by the suspect that may help identify and locate him. Officers will be continuing their investigation throughout the evening.

The victim remains hospitalized with moderate non-life threatening injuries.
