Incident: Vehicle Burglary and Arrest

Narrative:

On the above date and time, the Ventura Police Department Command Center received a call of a vandalism to a vehicle parked to the rear of Bombay Bar and Grill, 143 S. California St. The vehicle's owner was an employee of the bar and was able to view video surveillance footage of the parking lot. On the video, the employee saw the suspect, later identified as the suspect, Robert Camacho, breaking the driver's window of his vehicle and entering inside. He then realized that Camacho was standing in front of the bar waiting to be picked up by an UBER service. With the assistance of the bar's security, Camacho was detained and waited for officers to arrive.

During the investigation, officers learned that Camacho shattered the window of the victim's vehicle and stole property from inside. He was arrested and booked into the Ventura County Jail for burglary.
