Ventura's Transportation Division announces additional truck traffic scheduled for three months during hospital construction project

Beginning April 22, the City of Ventura's Transportation Division advises drivers to be aware of additional truck traffic scheduled through July 2014 as part of the Ventura County Medical Center (VCMC) Hospital Replacement Wing construction project. The city issued a Haul Route Permit to Tri County Transportation, which identifies specific routes and times to operate vehicles and machinery within the public right of way.

Following are the three approved routes and times based on safety, daily traffic flow and nearby schools:

Route A 8:30pm-4:30pm, Monday - Friday

Hillmont Avenue, Loma Vista Road (near Loma Vista Elementary School), Ashwood Avenue, Telegraph Road, Victoria Avenue, Olivas Park Drive

Route B 9am-12pm, Monday - Friday

Hillmont Avenue, Loma Vista Road, Main Street, Seaward Avenue (near Ventura High School), US 101, Valentine Road, Victoria Avenue, Olivas Park Drive

Route C 8:30-2:30 and 3:30 pm - 4:30pm, Monday - Friday

Hillmont Avenue, Loma Vista Road, Mills Road (near Anacapa Middle School), Telegraph Road, Thompson Blvd., Seaward Avenue, US 101, Valentine Road, Victoria Avenue, Olivas Park Drive
