The City of Ventura Public Art Program is looking for students (ages 16 and older) and adults interested in the arts and wishing to learn public art conservation techniques this summer from July 14 to August 15 (5 weeks).

Interns will meet Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10 am to 2 pm for workshops to observe demonstrations and receive training on proper conservation techniques and procedures before focusing on conserving Ventura Public Art sculptures along the Ventura River Trail and in the downtown area.
