Narrative:

Officers responded to a burglary alarm with a glass break in the 600 block of N. Ventura Ave. Arriving within a few minutes, they located a broken window to the front of the business. Officers checked the area and concluded the suspect fled the scene before their arrival.

An investigation revealed the suspect threw a rock through the businesses window, entering the store and hastily taking some display property. While the officers were on scene investigating, they were able to review the surveillance video at the business which showed the suspect fleeing the business with the stolen merchandise.
