Narrative:

On the above date and time, the Ventura Police Command Center received a 911 call reporting an injury traffic collision involving a vehicle and a pedestrian in the intersection of Seaward Ave and Harbor Blvd. Arriving officers, along with Ventura City Fire and medical personnel, found a 20 year old male lying in the intersection that was non-responsive due to the injuries suffered from the accident. There were several witnesses, including the driver of the vehicle on scene that attempted to render aid. Paramedics immediately treated the male and transported him to a hospital.

Officers on scene learned that the male was riding a skateboard southbound on Seaward Ave crossing the intersection with Harbor Blvd. The driver was traveling eastbound on Harbor Blvd when the front of his vehicle struck the male. The male suffered serious injuries as a result of the collision and is currently in the intensive care unit.

The Ventura Police Traffic Division responded to the scene to assist with the investigation. The investigation is still on-going and anyone with information regarding the traffic collision is encouraged to contact Sgt Darrick Brunk at (805) 339-4323.
