Narrative:

On the above date and time, the Ventura Police Command Center received numerous 911 calls reporting an injury traffic collision involving a single motorcycle in the intersection of Main Street and Loma Vista Road. Arriving officers, along with Ventura City Fire and medical personnel, found several passing motorists attending to the driver of the motorcycle, a 56-year-old male, who was non-responsive from his injuries he suffered in the collision. The victim was transported to Community Memorial Hospital and is currently undergoing treatment for his injuries.

The Ventura Police Department Traffic Unit responded to the scene and is conducting the investigation. Once further information has been obtained from the investigation, the Traffic Unit will send out an additional press release.

There is minimal impact to traffic in the area, so all roadways will remain open during the investigation.

The investigation into this incident is ongoing. Anyone with information related to this incident is urged to call the Ventura Police Department Traffic Unit at 339-4323.
