**Incident:** Stabbing

**Location:** 68 South Seaward Ave, Ventura

**Suspect(s):** Kyle Dean, 27 year old Ventura resident

**Victim:** Rogelio Coronel, 35 year old Ventura resident

**Narrative:**

On the above date and time, a Ventura Police Patrol Officer contacted the victim riding a bicycle in the area of Thompson Blvd and Coronado St. Coronel informed the Officer he had just been stabbed in the chest during an argument with the suspect, Kyle Dean, in front of 68 South Seaward. Coronel was transported to VCMC where he was treated for a non-life threatening stab wound to the chest.

Officers responded to 68 South Seaward and made contact with Dean. Dean was questioned and taken into custody without incident. The weapon used in the stabbing was located at the scene. Dean was transported to VCJ where he was booked for domestic violence with injuries, and Assault with a deadly weapon.
