Narrative:

On the above date and time, a Ventura Police patrol officer observed a suspicious four door sedan in the area of Thompson Boulevard and Seaward Avenue that matched the description of a recently reported stolen vehicle. The officer was able to quickly confirm the vehicle was in fact stolen and requested additional officers to assist.

Once additional officers were on scene, a traffic enforcement stop was conducted in the 76 Gas Station parking lot. The driver, Henry Dearcos was ordered out of the vehicle and was taken into custody without incident. A male passenger fled on foot and was not located.

Dearcos was placed under arrest and transported to Ventura County Jail where he was booked for possession of a stolen vehicle.
