UPDATE

Incident: Fatal Hit and Run Traffic Collision

Location: John F. Johnston Drive Located on the Ventura County Government Center Property

Date/Time Occurred: 04/25/17, 0803hrs

Officer(s) Involved: Ventura PD Patrol, Ventura PD Traffic Unit, Ventura City Fire, VCSCO

Suspect(s): Georgia Mae Casey, 31 Year Old Female, Ventura County Resident

Victim: 43 Year Old Female Ventura Resident

Narrative:

On 4/25/17 at approximately 0900hrs, the Ventura Police Department Command Center received a 911 call of a late reported hit and run on John F. Johnston Drive located on the Ventura County Government Center property. Initially, Ventura County Sheriff Office Deputies and Ventura City Fire responded to a down subject and medical aid was provided on scene. During initial investigation it was determined that the female was a victim of a hit and run. The Ventura Police Department's Traffic Unit was called out to investigate the scene. The 43 year old victim was transported to the Ventura County Medical Center by AMR and is in critical condition. The Ventura Police Department's Traffic Unit is asking for any help or leads with this investigation. In the evening hours of 4/25/17, the female victim of the hit and run succumbed to her injuries at the Ventura County Medical Center.

After a lengthy investigation, the Ventura Police Department Traffic Unit obtained an arrest warrant for Georgia Mae Casey for the charges of 191.5(b) PC – Vehicular Manslaughter, 20001(a) VC – Felony Hit and Run, 23152(c) VC – Driving While Addicted to a Drug, and 14601.5(a) VC – Driving on a Suspended License.

Today, members of the Ventura Police Traffic Unit and the Street Crimes Unit located Georgia Casey and took her into custody for the outstanding arrest warrant.
