Narrative: Ventura and Oxnard fire units responded to a reported structure fire. The first arriving crew found a two story residence with smoke in the interior. All occupants had appropriately evacuated the home after hearing a smoke alarm and seeing smoke. The crew investigated the source and found a fire that had been extinguished by a fire sprinkler system in an upstairs room of the home. Additional arriving resources evacuated smoke from the structure and performed protective salvage efforts for home furnishings and infrastructure. Crews confirmed extinguishment, ruled out further extension into structural components.

The cause of this fire is under investigation. No injuries were reported on this incident.
