Incident: Assault with a Deadly Weapon Arrest

## Narrative:

On the above date and time, the Ventura Police Department Command Center received a 911 call from a Downtown Ventura Park Ambassador reporting a disturbance at Mission Park, 190 E. Main St. The Park Ambassador reported that a subject, later identified as Lucero Luna, was disturbing passersby and throwing glass bottles. Officers arrived and determined that Luna had thrown a glass bottle in the direction of the ambassador and almost hit him.

At the conclusion of the investigation, Luna was arrested for assault with a deadly weapon and later booked into the Ventura County Jail.

A review of the Ventura County Superior Court website shows that Luna had been arrested 4 times in October 2018 and has three open cases for various charges such as trespassing, littering in public and a Municipal Code violation of being in a park after hours. She was also convicted of throwing a substance on a vehicle.
