Narrative: Fire units were dispatched to a reported structure fire. Upon arrival, the first crew discovered an RV well involved in fire with extension to 2 outdoor sheds, the eaves of the main house on the property and a vehicle parked adjacent to the motorhome. Firefighters initiated a rapid fire attack on the motorhome and shed to prevent further spread. Additional arriving crews assisted with fire attack and made entry into the interior and attic of the home to confirm no involvement. There were no injuries to Firefighters or civilians as a result of this incident. The cause of this fire is under investigation.
