Ventura opens City Hall and facilities to the public on March 10, 2022

Ventura, Calif. — Ventura will reopen City Hall and its facilities to the public on Thursday, March 10, 2022.

“This week’s reopening marks an important milestone as we proudly welcome everyone back for in-person service,” said Ventura City Manager Alex D. McIntyre. “I am thankful for our essential workers and staff who adapted quickly throughout the pandemic to serve the community with dedication, commitment, and a spirit of resiliency.”
