Narrative:

On the above date and time, a Ventura Police Department Patrol Officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle that matched the description of a vehicle involved in a catalytic converter theft that occurred in Santa Barbara County. The traffic stop lead to a search of the vehicle. The search uncovered several catalytic converters, tools used to remove catalytic converters and drug paraphernalia.

Both suspects were arrested for Possession of Stolen Property, Possession of Burglary Tools, Conspiracy, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Both suspects were from the Los Angeles.
