

Incident: Sex Offender Compliance Sweep

Location: Various

Date/Time Occurred: 5/31/2022

Officer(s) Involved: Ventura Police Department, Oxnard Police Department, Ventura County Probation, Ventura County Sheriff's Department, FBI, State Parole

Narrative:

On May 31, 2022, the Ventura Police Department in partnership with the above allied agencies, conducted a series of sex offender compliance checks within the jurisdiction of the respective agencies. The offenders searched were on active California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR) State Parole and/or Probation in the County of Ventura. Compliance checks are done regularly to ensure high risk offenders are following their court ordered restrictions.

Officers visited the residence of 44 offenders, and of those, four arrests were made:

- Robert Delachica (9/23/72), Oxnard resident, Violation of Probation
- Andrew Littlejohn (8/8/90), Camarillo resident, Violation of Probation
- Joseph Hall (10/5/81), Oxnard resident, Violation of Probation
- James Smith (12/3/72), Ventura resident, Felony possession of narcotics

Unrelated to the compliance sweep, but at the location of the sweep, two additional arrests were made:

- Sophia Olmos (10/7/88) Camarillo resident, possession of narcotics
- Phillip Feldsott (2/26/70) Oxnard resident, possession of narcotics
