Narrative: On the above date and time, fire units were dispatched to a report of smoke and flames inside a single-family home. Firefighters arrived to find smoke and flames coming from the rear of the house. Firefighters made access to the structure, located the seat of the fire in the kitchen and began to extinguish the fire while performing a search of the house for victims. Two dogs were removed from the smoke charged structure: one deceased. The second dog was returned to its owners with no injuries. The fire was extinguished 22 minutes after the call was received.

The cause of the fire remains under investigation. No firefighters were injured as a result of this incident.
