Ventura, Calif. — Ventura Mayor Sofia Rubalcava will present the annual State of the City Address to the public during the City Council meeting on Monday, October 10, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. The meeting will be hosted in the Council Chambers, as well as live streamed on the City's YouTube channel.

"There have been so many people, groups, non-profits, and local agencies that have worked together to meet every challenge with hope, encouragement, and positive solutions," said Mayor Rubalcava. "As we look ahead at future goals, I'm reminded of the hard-working City staff who make all initiatives a reality. There is truly so much to celebrate."

During the 2022 State of the City Address, highlighted topics will include an overview of the Fiscal Year 2022-23 budget, community survey results, progress on Council adopted initiatives, Economic Development updates, encouragement to get involved in the City's General Plan Update, and recent accomplishments from various City departments.
