**Narrative:** On the above date and time fire units were dispatched to a reported structure fire. First arriving firefighters reported smoke and fire from the second floor of a two-story multi-unit townhouse. Firefighters forced entry into the burning building, located the seat of the fire and began fire suppression while doing a search for victims in the building. The fire was extinguished 21 minutes after firefighters arrived.

The cause of the fire remains under investigation. No injuries were reported as a result of this incident.
