**Incident:** Possession of Narcotics with a Firearm Arrest

**Narrative:**

On the above date and time, officers were dispatched with Ventura City Fire and Paramedics to a report of two subjects slumped over inside a vehicle in the parking lot. When officers arrived, they saw what looked like powdered fentanyl in Schroeder's possession. During the arrest an officer was exposed to the fentanyl and had to be treated at the hospital.

The subsequent investigation revealed burglary tools and a loaded firearm in the vehicle. Schroeder was arrested and booked at the Ventura County Jail for possession of narcotics, burglary tools, and possession of narcotics with a loaded firearm.
