“The 2023 Spring Activity Guide is one of the most visually colorful and interactive versions we’ve created so far,” said Recreation Manager Emily Fox. “Residents can flip through the pages online or in-print and find over 150 classes offered in areas such as aquatics, adult sports, youth camps, theatre, art, special events, and more.”

Additional copies are available for pick-up at City Hall and other City facilities during business hours, including the Westpark Community Center, Barranca Vista Community Center, Ventura Aquatics Center, and Ventura Avenue Adult Center.
