**Narrative:** On the above date and time the Ventura County Fire Communication Center received multiple calls in regard to a traffic collision. Fire personnel arrived on scene within minutes of the initial call and found a passenger vehicle with extensive damage and a victim trapped. The vehicle was stabilized and extensive extrication was deployed to remove the victim and transport the victim to the Emergency Room with fire personnel via ambulance. The cause of the incident remains under investigation and the Ventura City Fire Department would like to remind the public that seatbelts save lives.
