Narrative: Ventura City Fire personnel responded to a reported structure fire. First arriving crews found a single story, single family residential structure charged with light smoke and occupants evacuating. Upon further investigation it was determined that a fire had started in a clothes dryer and had ignited adjacent combustible items in the laundry room. The fire was quickly extinguished, with no extension to other parts of the structure. The interior of the structure was thoroughly ventilated using smoke ejectors, and the family was once again able to reoccupy the residence upon completion of the incident. No injuries were reported at the time of this release.
