Narrative:

On 9-23-15, the Ventura Police Motor Unit conducted a "Court sting operation" to cite individuals driving from court after having their driver's license suspended or revoked. In addition a "stakeout" of repeat DUI offender probationers who have suspended or revoked driver's license was also conducted.

As a result of these two operations, two drivers were cited for driving on a suspended license while leaving court. During the stakeout operation two drivers were cited for driving on a suspended license, two were cited for driving without a license and five others were cited for miscellaneous traffic violations. For the day, four vehicles were impounded.

These operations are run as part of a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) which is a year-long program aimed at preventing deaths and injuries on our roadways through special enforcement and public awareness efforts. The grant helps aid in the city's ongoing effort to improve traffic safety and quality of life to its neighborhoods.
