Narrative:

On the above date and time, officers responded to a call of suspicious circumstances at a residence in the 1800 block of Topaz Ave. The caller reported seeing an unknown subject, later identified as Dan Hulseley, sleeping on the doorstep of a neighbor's residence. Hulseley was said to be in a sleeping bag.

When the first officer arrived on scene and contacted Hulseley, he found that he had a firearm on the ground next to him. Additional officers arrived and took Hulseley into custody.

The investigation revealed the firearm, along with several other items of property found in Hulseley's possession, was stolen out of an unreported burglary to a motorhome in Saticoy. The Ventura County Sheriff's Department responded and assisted by taking the burglary report. All of the property was returned to the owner.

Hulseley was arrested and booked into the Ventura County Jail for being a felon in possession of a firearm and possession of stolen property.
