Narrative:

On the above date and time, patrol officers responded to an apartment in the 1200 block of South Petit regarding the suspect disturbing, making threats at his ex-girlfriend's family's residence. As officers arrived at the residence and began their investigation, the suspect walked out of the apartment. When officers attempted to talk with him, he fled from them and ran back inside. The officers pursued him into the residence, and as they caught him, he continued to resist the officers. During the struggle, a loaded firearm fell from the suspect's possession. After the brief struggle, the suspect was taken into custody.

At the conclusion of the investigation, the suspect was booked for Criminal Threats, Prohibited Person in Possession of a Firearm and Resisting Arrest. No one was injured during this incident.
