Narrative:

On July 9, 2015, at approximately 1039 hrs, the Ventura Police Command Center received a 911 call regarding a subject armed with a knife threatening another individual at the Bus Depot, located at 3330 Telegraph Rd.

The victim Arthur Munoz was at the Bus Depot sitting in his wheel chair, and was attempting to collect his money that had fallen to the ground from his pocket. The suspect McIntock walked up and started picking up Munoz's money off of the ground and was claiming it as his own. An argument ensued between the two men when McIntock brandished a knife and threatened to kill Munoz. McIntock attempted to stab Munoz but was unsuccessful.

Officers responding to the area apprehended McIntock attempting to flee the scene. He was taken into custody without incident and booked at the county jail for an assault with a deadly weapon and attempted robbery. Munoz was not injured and his money was returned to him.
