Narrative:

On May 29, 2015 at &:47 PM, an alert citizen in the 100 block of East Barnett Street called the Ventura Police Command Center and reported suspicious activity at a residence on the street. As officers arrived on scene, they found the suspect as he was jumping over a rear fence, leaving the residence's backyard. He was in possession of property from the house, and the subsequent investigation revealed he had just burglarized the home. The suspect's vehicle, which was parked nearby, was searched, and additional property unrelated to the house he had just burglarized was found inside of it. The property in the vehicle was traced back to a separate, unreported residential burglary, which had occurred earlier in the day, in the 100 block of North Oak Street in Ventura.

The suspect was arrested and later booked into the Ventura County Jail for residential burglary and an unrelated warrant out of Wyoming. All of the recovered stolen property was returned to the rightful owners.
