Incident: Grand Theft, Elder Abuse with Arrest

Narrative:

On March 25, 2015, the Victim discovered that a substantial amount of cash was missing from his safe deposit box at his bank in Ventura. The Victim notified the Ventura Police Department and a patrol officer responded to file a crime report. Shortly thereafter, a Major Crimes Detective was assigned to the case and began investigating. Over the course of the investigation, the Detective discovered that around the time of the theft, a family member of the Victim (Suspect – Nancy Gordon) illegally gained access to the Victim's safe deposit box and possibly had possession of the Victim's money.

Over the next several weeks, Detectives executed search warrants in Oxnard and Camarillo and recovered a large amount of the Victim's money and evidence that linked Gordon to the crime. On May 11, 2015, Gordon was booked at the Ventura County Jail for Grand Theft and Elder abuse.
