**Narrative:**

On May 12, 2015 at 6:51 AM, the Ventura Police Command Center received a call reference a suspicious occupied vehicle parked on Thille Street, East of Holmes Ave. Officers arrived on scene and contacted the two occupants of the vehicle. While speaking with the occupants, the driver (Kelly) accelerated, nearly striking one of the officers on scene. Kelly continued in a northwest direction driving over the center median, striking a parked vehicle and Edison light pole, where the vehicle came to rest. The two subjects were taken into custody at the scene.

Further investigation revealed the vehicle in question was a stolen vehicle that had been outfitted with unreported stolen license plates. A search of the vehicle revealed several guns, several thousand rounds of ammunition, explosives, drugs, drug paraphernalia and forged checks.

The Ventura Police Department Streets Crime Unit and Ventura County Bomb Squad responded to assist in the investigation. The subjects in question were later booked at VCJ on numerous felony charges. No officers were injured during this incident.
