Narrative:

On the above date and time, the Ventura Police Department Command Center received a 911 call from the victim reporting that he was the victim of a brandishing after confronting the suspect, later identified as Refujio Ruvalcaba, about him using derogatory language and disturbing customers sitting outside of the Habit restaurant. The victim, Ryan, was also a customer at the restaurant.

After a brief verbal argument between the two, Ruvalcaba removed a folding knife from his pocket and brandished the knife in a threatening manner at Ryan. Ryan went inside the restaurant and call 911. Ruvalcaba left the area on foot.

Officers responded to the call and detained Ruvalcaba at the corner of Main St. and Chestnut. He was positively identified as the suspect and arrested. Ruvalcaba was booked into the Ventura County Jail from brandishing.

No one was injured as a result of this incident.
