Narrative:

On the above date and time, the Ventura Police Department Command Center received a 911 call from the victim indicating he was the victim of a brandishing after getting into a verbal argument with the suspect over a road rage incident. The victim was able to provide the dispatcher a description of the suspect vehicle, which was last seen leaving the area eastbound on Santa Clara St.

Several minutes later, a patrol officer saw the suspect vehicle traveling on Telegraph Rd. near 5 Points. Additional officers responded, and when they determined it was safe for them to pull the vehicle over, a high-risk stop was initiated. The vehicle was stopped in the 5900 Block of Hunter St. and the suspect, later identified as Camachoa, was taken into custody.

During a search of his vehicle, a loaded firearm was found concealed under his seat. Camachoa was positively identified and arrested for Brandishing a Firearm and Possession of a Concealed Firearm in a Vehicle. He was booked into the Ventura County Jail.

No one was injured as a result of this incident. The nearby schools were briefly put on lockdown until the suspect was safely taken into custody.
