Narrative:

On the above date and time, a Ventura Police Officer was patrolling the area of Montalvo Elementary School, 2050 Grand Ave., when he observed a suspicious vehicle drive into the parking lot of the school and park. The officer contacted the vehicle's driver and a passenger, later identified as Daniel Rockett. The female driver of the vehicle was found to have a suspended license.

During a search of the vehicle, officers located evidence that led them to believe there was a handgun inside the vehicle. After the search of the vehicle did not produce any weapons, officers searched the area and found a loaded handgun in the parking lot of the school close to where the vehicle was parked. They also found discarded illegal narcotics.

It was determined that Rockett had discarded the firearm and controlled substance prior to the officer making contact with them in the vehicle. He was arrested for possession of a loaded firearm, carrying a loaded firearm in a vehicle, possession of a loaded firearm in a school zone and possession of a controlled substance. He was booked into the Ventura County Jail for the above charges.

The female driver was cited and released.
