Ventura City Fire personnel responded to a reported structure fire. First arriving crews found a fully involved two-car garage threatening adjoining and nearby structures. Fire crews initiated an aggressive attack on the fire and were successful in minimizing extension into the attached residential occupancy. After extensive overhaul of the garage the attached residence was determined to be uninhabitable. 1 adult male victim was displaced from the affected residence and was assisted by Red Cross. 1 Firefighter was transported to a local hospital with minor burn injuries sustained during suppression activities. The cause of the fire is under investigation.
