Narrative:

On the above date and time, officers responded to a report of a wanted subject seen in the area of a residence in the 700 block of Arbor St. While checking the area, officers saw Arreola, who matched the description of the wanted subject, and attempted to contact him. As officers were contacting Arreola, he swung a backpack he was carrying at one of the officers and fled on foot. Arreola entered several backyards of residences in the area and began going yard to yard with officers pursuing him on foot. Officers briefly lost sight of Arreola and set up a perimeter of the area. He was caught and taken in custody as he was attempting to flee again in the 400 block of Emma St.

For the safety of students and staff, Blanch Reynolds Elementary school was placed on lockdown for approximately 20 minutes, while the officers searched for Arreola.

After being treated at the seen by Ventura City Fire for minor injuries he sustained during the foot pursuit, Arreola was transported and booked into Ventura County Jail for multiple felony and misdemeanor warrants, resisting arrest and possession of stolen property.

Arreola was not the original subject with the warrant officers were looking for, but in addition to the warrants, he was found to be in possession of property stolen from a vehicle burglary in the area.

No officers or citizens were injured as a result of the incident.
