Ventura City Fire Department personnel responded to a report of two male juveniles having seizures in a barranca adjacent to a residential neighborhood. First arriving crews found two male juvenile victims who were incapacitated, due to an apparent altered level of consciousness, and suffering from exposure. A roadside chain link fence was removed, and thick brush cleared away, to make access to the victims using low-angle rope rescue equipment. Both victims were successfully removed from the barranca in a short period of time and were transported to local hospitals via ambulance.
