Date/Time Occurred: 8/26 through 8/29/14

Narrative:

The City of Ventura has received information from the National Weather Service of High Surf expected beginning Tuesday, August 26th through August 29th.

The combination of the high surf and tides of up to 10 to 15 feet could cause some local coastal flooding of low-lying areas during this period. State Lifeguards suggest avoiding exposed beach and rock areas close to the surf line. The City of Ventura with the cooperation of State Parks/Lifeguards is monitoring the High Surf and will issue updates as needed.

In the interest of public safety, coastal swimming (due to potentially severe riptides), wading and water sports should be avoided during this advisory.
