The suspects were identified as Kenneth Lee Cox, 34 year old Ventura resident, Jacob Pulido, 27 year old Ventura resident, and Gabriel Cueva, 19 year old Ventura resident.

Narrative:

On the above date and time the Ventura Police Department Command Center received a 911 call reporting a robbery. The victim was approached by three suspects in front of the Red Barn Liquor. The suspects confronted the victim and demanded money from him. Then they physically attacked the victim by punching and kicking him. The victim sustained minor injuries but they were not life threatening.

All three suspects were described as Hispanic males, 25-30 yrs, ranging in height from 5'6-5'11. They were all wearing dark clothing, and fled in an unknown direction.

During the course of follow up investigation by VPD detectives all three suspects in this case were identified. The case was submitted to the Ventura County District Attorney's Office and charges of 211 PC Robbery, 186.22 (a) PC Participation in a gang crime, and 186.22 (b) PC, Committing a crime in association with and or for the benefit of a criminal street gang were filed.

Suspect Kenneth Cox was taken into custody on 1/6/16 in Ventura.

Suspect Jacob Pulido was taken into custody on 1/7/16 in Ventura.

For the next few weeks, Ventura Police Detectives tracked the third suspect, Gabriel Cueva, to Las Vegas. On 2/11/16 Las Vegas Metro Police Department located suspect Cueva and took him into custody without incident. Cueva is due to be transported back to Ventura County where he faces the above listed pending charges.
