Date/Time of Incident: June 11th, 2014, 2:45 PM

Incident Location: Darling Road / Wells Road in Ventura, CA

Injuries: 8 patients with minor injuries (2 requiring extrication)

Equipment: 2 ALS Engines, 1 BLS Engine, 1 ALS Ladder Truck, 2 Command, 4 Ambulances, 2 EMS Overhead

Agencies Involved: Ventura City Fire Department, Ventura County Fire Department, Ventura Police Department, Ventura County EMS Authority, American Medical Response

Ventura City Fire Department responded to a reported traffic collision with multiple vehicles involved. First arriving units found multiple vehicles involved, multiple patients with minor to moderate injuries, 2 of which were entrapped within a damaged vehicle leaking fuel, off the roadway in an agricultural field. A Level-1 MCI was declared, patients were triaged and placed in temporary treatment areas. 2 patients were successfully extricated from the damaged vehicle by truck company personnel using specialized hydraulic rescue tools. 8 total adult male patients were transported via ambulance to nearby trauma center hospitals.
