**Narrative:**

On the above date and time the Ventura Police Command Center received a call re: a male subject who had just damaged two large planters in front of the San Buenaventura Mission on E Main Street.

Officers responded and detained a male vagrant, identified as Benjamin Holladay, who matched the description of the suspect that had been provided by the witnesses.

Holladay, for unknown reasons, deliberately pushed over and damaged the two planters that had been positioned directly outside the front doors of the mission. These planters are church property and Holliday was arrested for felony vandalism.

He was transported to the Ventura County Main Jail and booked on the charge of 594.3(a) PC – Vandalism to a Church Facility
