**** UPDATE ****

On 05/11/2014 at approximately 1531 hrs, the Ventura Police Command Center received a call from an employee at Cordello's pizza located at 1700 E. Thompson Boulevard. The employee reported that a subject was refusing to leave the business and while inside the business he attempted to open the cash register. Ventura Police Officers responded to the area and located the subject identified as Anthony Barraza.

Officers recognized that Barraza matched the description of the suspect who was involved in the attempted robbery at Casa De Soria. Barraza was positively identified as the suspect in that incident and was arrested. Barraza was booked into Ventura County Jail for attempted robbery and attempted commercial burglary.

Narrative:

On the above date and time, Ventura Police Officers responded to an attempted robbery at Casa De Soria located at 1961 E. Thompson Boulevard.

Upon arriving, investigating Officers determined that the suspect entered the business, simulated a weapon in his shirt, and demanded money from an employee. The suspect left the business before obtaining money and was last seen going west from the business along Thompson Boulevard. Ventura Police Officers searched the area but were unable to locate the suspect.
