**Narrative:**

On the above date, and between the listed times, officers were dispatched to a call reference a late reported vandalism to a vehicle in the 6900 block of Heron St. Upon the arrival of the first officer, it was discovered several other vehicles had been vandalized in the surrounding neighborhood, specifically on the streets listed above. The vehicles had been spray painted and one vehicle had the windows smashed out. Additionally, several buildings were found to have been spray painted at the Bible Fellowship Church in the 6900 block of Ralston St.

Investigating officers learned the possible suspect in the vandalisms was related to one of the reported victims. Officers contacted the suspect, Alec Pedroza, who was identified as the son of the original reporting victim. Pedroza admitted to committing all of the vandalisms, saying he was upset with his parents. Physical evidence found on Pedroza also connected him to the crimes.

Pedroza was booked into Ventura County Jail for multiple counts of felony vandalism.
