**Narrative:**

On the above date and time, officers responded to the area of the Pacific View Mall reference a call of a vehicle vandalism that just occurred with the victim reportedly chasing the suspect on foot.

When the first officers arrived on scene, they discovered the victim lost sight of the suspect in the 600 block of Empire St. Using the description obtained by the victim, officers began checking the area for the suspect. While officers were searching the area, the Ventura Police Department's Command Center began receiving additional calls from residents in the area reporting the suspect trying vehicle door handles in the area of Porter Ln. and Strathmore Dr.

Officers responded to that location and located the suspect. The suspect, later identified as Andres Flores, was taken into custody without further incident.

During the investigation, officers learned that Flores had unlawfully entered an unoccupied residence through an unlocked rear door in the 600 block of Empire St. and in the area of the 3200 block of Porter Ln., he attempted to enter a locked vehicle which was occupied by a 12 year old female.

Flores was booked into the Ventura County Jail for vandalism, unlawful entry into a residence and child annoyance.

No one was injured as a result of these crimes.
