Narrative:

On 02/16/14, at about 10:56 a.m., the Ventura Police Command Center received a call of a burglary in progress to a used car dealership in the 2200 block of Thompson Blvd. The reporting party told dispatchers a female subject had smashed a window to the business and was in the process of removing property.

Responding officers arrived on scene within minutes locating the suspect removing computer components through a smashed window to the business. Officer quickly detained the suspect who was identified as Johanna Ginther.

Officers conducted an investigation and determined Ginther committed two vehicle burglaries to cars parked on the dealership lot. Ginther smashed the windows to the vehicles removing property from inside. Ginther then smashed a window to the dealerships building where she again was taking property from inside and piling it up outside the business. According to a witness Ginther made multiple trips inside the business, until officers arrived on scene and took Ginther into custody.

No one was injured as a result of this incident.

Johanna Ginther was taken into custody and booked into the Ventura County Jail for commercial burglary, vehicle burglary, and possession of drug paraphernalia.
