Focus of this Workshop:

At the request of stakeholders, the RWQCB extended the deadline for comments on the Estuary Subwatershed Study Synthesis Report until July 15, 2011. A revised Synthesis Report will be due to the RWQCB by Sept 15, 2011 to incorporate comments received, as appropriate. The RWQCB also requested that the City host another Stakeholder Workshop in attempt to gain consensus on the alternatives presented in the Report and to determine how best to move forward.

At this workshop we will summarize the comments received, discuss additional information that will be added to the report and solicit input on the alternatives and the data gaps that still need to be filled. The input received at this workshop will be used to complete the synthesis study and to develop a new recommendations memorandum for submittal to the RWQCB.
