

Subject: Ordinance for Second Reading - Amending Division 2, "Administration," Part 2, "City Council," Chapter 2.210, "General Provisions" of the San Buenaventura Municipal Code to Establish a District Based Electoral System, Adopt a Map Describing the Boundaries of Each District, and Identifying the Districts to Hold a District Based Election in 2018 and 2020 to Implement District-Based Elections (Elections Code § 10010)
